- 5. Assisting with the organization of advisory boards, consultancy meetings, and internal scientific training
- 6. Hosting cross-functional journal club presentations to update internal personnel on new publications
- 7. Supporting incoming Advanced Pharmacy Practice Experience (APPE) PharmD students throughout their rotation
- 8. Completing a high-impact Residency Project that meets the organization's business needs while also fulfilling the University of Toronto IPRP requirements
